

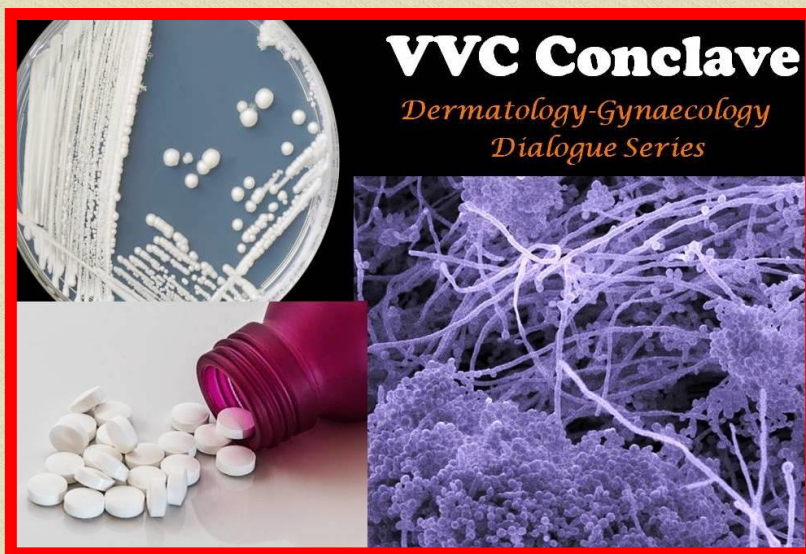

WELCOME MESSAGE

Hitherto easily treatable by a single dose of fluconazole or clotrimazole pessaries, the yeasts causing VVC have over the years undergone an oceanic change in terms of the responsible species of *Candida*, and the resistance of the yeast to multiple antifungal drugs. Apart from standard antifungal drug resistance mechanisms like efflux pumps especially **AZOLE MENACE**, the formation of bio-films by practically all yeasts causative of VVC is rendering this condition recurrent and complicated, culminating into distressed patients and frustrated health care givers.

Optimal treatment of a condition like VVC commences with understanding of the changing epidemiology, wavering microbiological etiology, and pharmacodynamic properties of antifungal drugs including the existing armamentarium, novel and often hyped molecules as well as experimental approaches. Physicians involved in the management of VVC **MUST HAVE** an in-depth understanding of the yeasts' mechanisms of developing drug-resistance, knowledge of thorough investigations that have now become imperative even for a "simple curdy white vaginal discharge", and explore and put to use the apparently 'non-fancy' and 'old-yet-going strong' antifungal agents, to hopefully provide the troubled patients long lasting, if not permanent, relief from the sufferings of this apparently *minor infection*.
